Participants set the agenda in a facilitated retreat style session that focuses specifically on each participant's leadership roles and organizational challenges. Participants come with the specific challenges they are facing in their roles and in their organizations. Utilizing an "open space" format, participants choose the topics. Brief presentations are made on the topics and the balance of the allotted time is used to workshop each topic with discussion, exercises and the sharing of best (and worst) practices. In the process, each leader is able to workshop his or her leadership challenges.

## Course Details

The courses will begin at 10am on the 1st day, and dismiss at around 6pm. The 2nd day session will begin at 8:30am and conclude about 3:30pm.

There is a \$100 registration fee for each level of the Leadership Academy. Do not send payment at this time.

NOTE: Leadership Academy courses must be attended in order. Level III cannot be taken without attending Levels I and II. Levels I, II and III must be taken prior to Level IV.

Participants are responsible for lodging arrangements and costs, as well as transportation. A \$300 per participant grant reimbursement is available through DEMST. Also note the hotel block deadline, hotel availability in Bismarck is very limited.
