Purpose of Public Notice

The Department intends to reissue the following North Dakota Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NDPDES) Discharge Permit under the authority of Section 61-28-04 of the North Dakota Century Code.

Facility Description

The reapplication is for the water treatment plant which services the City of Fargo. The reissuance is for the discharge of wastewater from the reverse osmosis concentrate and the current lime softening treatment system during unavoidable discharge situations. The facility produces approximately 12 mgd of potable water to the City of Fargo. The water treatment plant is located in the city of Fargo at 435 14th Avenue South. Any discharge from this location would be to the Red River of the North, a Class I stream.

Tentative Determinations

Proposed effluent limitations and other permit conditions have been made by the Department. They assure that State Water Quality Standards and applicable provisions of the FWPCAA will be protected.
