

The North Dakota Family Planning Program Medical Protocol Manual has been prepared as a guide for delegate agencies in the provision of medical services. Harbor-UCLA Medical Center Protocols were utilized as the foundation for the majority protocols in the manual. A number of other sources reflective of national and international standards of care were referenced in updates and revisions of the protocols. These are referenced on each protocol.

The manual is separated into section for ease in finding the protocols. Each section has a section-specific table of contents.

The protocols in this manual are subject to change as new evidence based practice is recommended by national accredited organizations. The ND FPP utilizes ACOG, USTA, WHO and CDC as their accredited organizations. As changes occur and new protocols are developed, they will be forwarded for addition to the manual.
