INFL (high dose)	FLUZONE – HIGH DOSE	high dose seasonal, preservative free	
INFL (IIV3 P/F)	AGRIFLU, FLUARIX, Afluria-preservative free, FLUVIRIN-PRESERVATIVE FREE, FLUZONE-PRESERVATIVE FREE	seasonal, trivalent, injectable, preservative free	
INFL (IIV4 P/F)	Fluarix-quadrivalent, Fluzone-quadrivalent	seasonal, quadrivalent, injectable, preservative free	
INFL (IIV3 id-P/F)	Fluzone, intradermal	seasonal, preservative free, intradermal injection	
INFL (IIV3 W/P)	AFLURIA, FLULAVAL, FLUVIRIN, FLUZONE	seasonal, trivalent, injectable, with preservative	
INFL (LAIV3)	FLUMIST-trivalent	live, attenuated, for intranasal use	For historical use only – cannot enter new lots with this type of influenza vaccine
INFL (LAIV4)	Flumist-quadrivalent	live, attenuated, intranasal, quadrivalent	
INFL (ccIIV3)	Flucelvax	seasonal, trivalent, cell-cultured, injectable, preservative free	
INFL (RIV3)	FLUBlok	seasonal, trivalent, recombinant, injectable, preservative free	
INFL (whole)		whole virus	For historical use only – cannot enter new lots with this type of influenza vaccine
INFL (unknown)		unspecified/unknown formulation	used to record a seasonal influenza vaccine where the exact formulation is not known
