**RE:** State-Supplied MMRV and DTaP/IPV Vaccines

**DATE:** January 24, 2011

Due to supply issues, the North Dakota Department of Health (NDDoH) will be unable to obtain ProQuad®, the measles, mumps, rubella and varicella combination vaccine, for Vaccines for Children (VFC) eligible children. Orders for ProQuad® placed through the NDDoH after Friday, January 28th, will not be filled. After this date, providers will need to order MMR and varicella vaccines separately.

Kinrix®, the DTaP/IPV combination vaccine, will be unavailable in the syringe presentation until April. While vials can be ordered at this time, it is anticipated that supply issues at McKesson will intermittently restrict the availability of Kinrix® vials also. Single antigen DTaP and IPV vaccines are available for order.
