**RE:** NDIIS Mandate Update

**DATE:** June 13, 2011

The 2011 Legislative Assembly made a change to the North Dakota Century Code (23-01-05.3) which requires all healthcare providers in North Dakota to enter childhood immunizations into the North Dakota Immunization Information System (NDIIS).

Effective **July 1, 2011**, the law now requires that all childhood doses (including influenza) be entered into the NDIIS within four weeks of administration or the North Dakota Department of Health (NDDoH) shall report the appropriate healthcare provider to their occupational licensing entity. The law also restricts healthcare providers from ordering vaccines from the NDDoH if they are not complying with entering doses into the NDIIS within four weeks.
